EXTERIOR CHANGE REQUESTS

One of the most common issues in our community is the EXTERIOR CHANGE REQUEST. A copy of this is included in the Residents Guide and online. As our community ages there is an increased need for exterior changes, this includes, windows, lampposts, decks, garage doors and plantings that have potential to grow taller than 3 feet (as well as large planting removal). This is not a complete list if you are not sure it is a good idea to submit an Exterior Change Request in order to avoid request for removal or a fine. The exterior standards are designed with a goal of maintaining property values.

WEATHER/LAWNCARE/SNOW REMOVAL

This year a combined very rainy fall and an early snow meant for undesirable fall clean up. Although we are not alone as any drive around town shows lawns covered with leaves and piles on the side of the road. Our situation is not up to our standards. Edgewater is in contact with Grastorf to deal with the issue as weather allows.

Snow removal plan does not always coincide actual snowfall. Your patience is appreciated while waiting for snowfall to end and plowing to begin.

<u>REMINDER:</u> All vehicles must be removed from plow areas. If a vehicle is in area to be plowed the snow will be removed from around the vehicle and it will be the homeowners responsibility to remove the snow. The contractors will not stop to attempt contact with vehicle owners. This time consuming process would slow down a process that needs be done as quickly as possible.
